### Level Crossing Renewal – Whitland Update

Our work to renew Whitland Level crossing will commence in February. We are planning to replace the level crossing barriers and display lights. To do this we need to install new trackside signaling equipment and install new cables beneath Station Road.

The work will take place from Friday 15 February until Monday 4 March and will require a full closure of the crossing at the times indicated below.

A signposted diversion route will be in place (please see map enclosed). The pedestrian footbridge will remain open at all times and level access will be provided for those who are unable to use it.

Safety is a key priority and for this reason a large amount of this work must be carried out while trains are not running. This means carrying out a lot of our improvements during the night and at weekends.

During the work Network Rail staff and our partners are briefed to work responsibly in the local community. Please be aware that the equipment we use means some disturbance is unavoidable, however we will make every effort to minimise any unnecessary noise.
